We come before you in gratitude for the blessings of education and the upcoming school holidays.

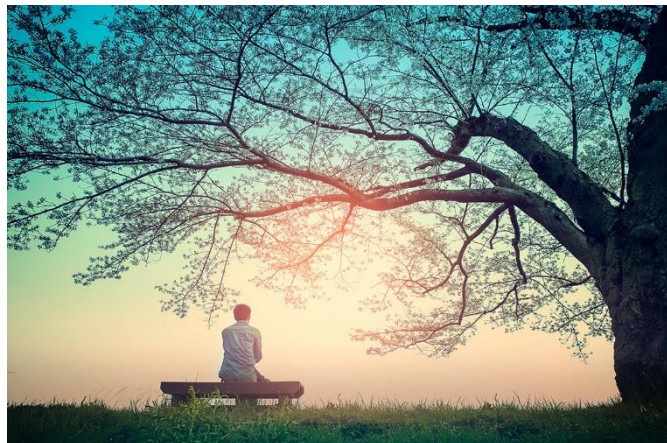
Thank you for the opportunity to rest and rejuvenate. Watch over each student, family member, and staff member during this time, keeping them safe from harm and providing joyful experiences.

NAIDOC week celebrates the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. It is celebrated by all Australians and is a great opportunity to recognise and learn more about the history and culture of Indigenous communities.

NAIDOC stands for National Aborigines and Islanders Day Observance Committee. Its origins can be traced back to the Aboriginal rights movement, when on Australia Day 1938, protestors marched through the streets of Sydney to highlight the status and treatment of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Australians. Today, it is a week-long celebration held in July that consists of range of traditional and contemporary activities.

NAIDOC Week is an important event that helps build positive relationships between Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal people. It enables a deeper understanding of our differences and similarities and is a great opportunity for all Australians to eliminate bias and discrimination by reflecting and reconciling the wrongs of the past to facilitate hope and build a fairer future. Families are encouraged to join in and support young people in learning the significance of NAIDOC Week.

**SEASONS FOR GROWTH** - a program for children who have experienced grief.

Change and loss are issues that affect all of us at some stage in our lives. At St Francis of the Fields, we recognise that when changes occur in families through **death, separation, divorce** or related circumstances, children and young people may benefit from learning how to manage these changes effectively.

We are, therefore, offering a very successful education program called '**Seasons for Growth**'. This program is facilitated in small groups and is based on research that highlights the importance of social support and the need to practice new skills to cope effectively with change and loss. The program focuses on issues such as self-esteem, managing feelings, problem solving, decision making, effective communication and support networks.

**Seasons for Growth** runs for eight weeks, and each weekly session is 40-50 minutes during school hours. This program is being offered to all students.

**Seasons for Growth** will commence the second week of third term. If you think your son or daughter would benefit from **Seasons for Growth**, we encourage you to talk to him/her about this. Please fill out the 'interested' slip and return before Friday 19<sup>th</sup> July. (Please note this program is not recommended for students within the first 6 – 8 months following the event).

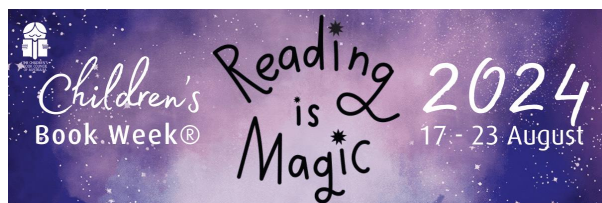

## Science News....

### What's been happening in Foundation Science?

We're thrilled to finally finish our party hats as the exciting culmination of our recent exploration into materials and their properties. The children designed and made party hats either suitable for a sunny or rainy day. Through this task, the children explored how materials behave and can be manipulated. They then proudly showcased their creations to their Grade 6 Buddies before taking the beautiful hats home.

Physical Science will be the focus next term as we learn about the way objects move and push and pull forces.



### What's been happening in Grade 3 Science?

Grade 3 children have been learning about materials and their properties for the last couple of weeks. Recently we looked at elastic and how it can be used. Children designed and constructed a toy using recycled materials that used elastic. The focus and teamwork students displayed was fantastic. It was really pleasing to see children problem solve and show flexible thinking when things didn't go as planned. Over the next term we'll be exploring more materials in depth- absorbent materials, tensile strength and insulation.
