#### **Orientation Day**

We have finally received an updated guideline that spells out how Orientation Days can be held while considering the covid-19 safety guidelines.

All 2021 children will be able to hold their Orientation day in a variety of formats.

#### Our 2021 Foundation children:

- We have been instructed that our kindergarten group sizes must not exceed public gathering limits of 20 people indoors. Subsequently, our 2021 Foundation classes of 22 children will need to be divided into two groups of 11 children each, plus several staff members.
- We will hold these 30-minute orientation sessions for our 2021 Foundation classes on Tuesday 8 December at
  - o 11.45am Group 1
  - o 12.30pm Group 2
- I ask that all parents drop their children off at the front of the school at either 11.45am or 12.30pm (depending on the time we give to you) in the pick-up/drop off zone. We will have the class teachers, Maree O'Connor (Counsellor), Linda Cartwright (Learning Diversity Leader) and myself waiting to collect the children and take them to their new classroom. Parents are asked to please pick your child up from school at either 12.15pm (if your child's session began at 11.45am); or 1.00pm (if your child's session commenced at 12.30pm).

- The school will allocate your child a time by Friday 4 December. I apologise for the delay in notifying parents of their time.
- Please know that we will take time in 2021 to meet with our parents when safe to do so.

#### Our 2021 Year 1-6 children:

- All Year 1-6 will move to their new 2021 classrooms with their new teachers and classmates from 11.45am-1.00pm.
- Any new students will be required to be dropped off at the front of the school at 11.40am and a Teacher Aide will take the children to their new class.
- Parents are asked to pick their children up from the front of the school at 1.00pm.

#### Our current Year 6 children:

 Those current Year 6 children whose Secondary schools are not yet able to offer an Orientation Day will be taught by our Creative Art teachers from 11.45 - 1.00pm.

I hope this Orientation session helps your child feel comfortable attending St. Francis of the Fields Primary School in 2021.

# 2020 Graduation Ceremony

On Wednesday 16th December we will celebrate the Year 6



students' graduation. The following information outlines the format of the evening.

The Year 6 Graduation Dinner will be in the Community Centre. We ask that the Year 6 students be at the Community Centre at <u>5.45pm</u>, as we will share a meal at 6pm. Only students and staff will attend this dinner.

Due to the easing of some of the Covid-19 restrictions, the Year 6 graduation ceremony will now be a Mass, celebrated outdoors on the soccer pitch at 7.00pm. Each student is allowed **two guests** only to ensure the school remains within Covid 19 parameters. Please note there will **NOT BE** a Live Streamed link for the Mass.

To ensure Covid 19 guidelines are adhered to, guests must reserve a place through the school interview system. We will send the link to all Year 6 parents - this will assist in contract tracing, if required. Dress code for the dinner and graduation for both boys and girls is to be neat, clean and casual - something that can be worn again.

#### **2021 Class Teachers**

The Class Structures for the 2021 Year have seen some changes from this year.

This time of year is always an exciting and nerve-wracking time. Will our children be placed with their friends? Will my child be placed with the teacher that I want?

Please note that we have many parent requests – some of which are contrary to each other. One parent will request, "Can Timmy be placed with Roger?" Whilst Roger's parents will ask that they be separated.

At these times we need to trust that each teacher at St. Francis of the Fields knows, loves and cares for your child. They have worked diligently on class lists for many hours trying to ensure each child will flourish in 2021.

Parents have an enormous role in how their child views the changes for 2021.

A positive parent will reassure that any new change will be a blessing – an opportunity for new friendships to be fostered and a chance to learn from a teacher who will support and care for them. These parents will find that their child develops resilience – an essential commodity necessary for adult life.

#### Swimming in 2021

The end of the year is quickly approaching. I hope you have a great holiday and enjoy the warm weather with your families. I am sure you will spend many a day swimming at the beach or in a pool.

The Year 3-6 children will have their swimming lessons on the first Monday back at school next year. Please ensure you have completed any permission forms sent through via PAM prior to the commencement of the 2021 school year.

### 2021 INSTRUMENTAL PROGRAM ENROLMENTS


