

Conveyance Allowance Program 2025

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that schools support eligible families to receive financial assistance with the cost of transporting students to and from school where the student:

 lives in rural and regional Victoria and attends their nearest appropriate school/campus

This policy applies to both government and non-government schools.

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for the conveyance allowance a student must reside **4.8km** or more from the school/campus they attend. This distance is measured as the shortest practicable route from the student's residence to the school/campus using all-weather public roads drivable by car.

Students attending a non-government school will be eligible to apply for the conveyance allowance if they attend their nearest non-government school.

Application forms

Families can complete the relevant application form (refer to list below) and submit it to the school, these forms are also available from the school office.

Form 1- Application for private car travel only to school

Form 2- Application for private bus travel only to school

Form 5- Application for muti-mode travel (Car & bus) to school
