I do not believe in the right of the strongest, nor the power of the oppressors.

I do not believe that I can fight oppression far away if I tolerate injustice here.

I do not believe that all suffering is in vain, nor that our dreams will remain dreams,

nor that death is the end.

But I dare to believe, always and in spite of everything, in a new humanity;

in God's own dream of a new heaven and a new earth where justice will flourish,

and peace will reign, in our land, in our world.

New Dates - Engagement of Volunteers

In order to meet the Child Safe Standards, the school requires all volunteers in our school, to complete the Engagement of Volunteers documentation. Part of the requirement is to attend an interview process at the school. (This is an informal chat in the staffroom)

During this time, we will attend to the Code of Conduct document that volunteers have signed along with the Child Safety Policy. We will answer any concerns or queries you have also. If you would like to volunteer at St. Francis please complete the Engagement of Volunteers documentation, which is available from our school office. The *Working with Children Act 2005 (Vic)* requires that any person doing child-related work, must have a valid Working with Children Check (WWCC). The school already requires that all school volunteers are required to apply for and pass a WWCC. There is no change to this requirement. There is no cost for volunteers applying for a WWCC. SchoolTV - Blended Families

Blended or stepfamilies, come in all shapes and sizes. Today, the term "blended family" is more commonly used as opposed to "stepfamily". Although their original meanings differ slightly, today both terms are used interchangeably. This is mostly due to some of the negative connotations associated with fairytale characters such as the evil stepmother or stepsister.



The blended family is the fastest growing family dynamic in the world with one in five families now being a 'step' or 'blended' family. However, when families "blend," it rarely progresses smoothly. Some children resist change, and parents become frustrated when the new family doesn't function in the same way as the previous one.

For many step-parent's, the greatest challenge lies in determining what their role is within the family. The process can be both rewarding and challenging. Children affected by the union of a new couple may not be excited at the prospect of becoming part of a new family.

Although blending families requires adjustment and patience from everyone involved, in this edition of SchoolTV, parents will be given some guidelines of real expectations that can help their new family work through the growing pains. We hope you take time to reflect on the information offered in this month's edition, and we always welcome your feedback.

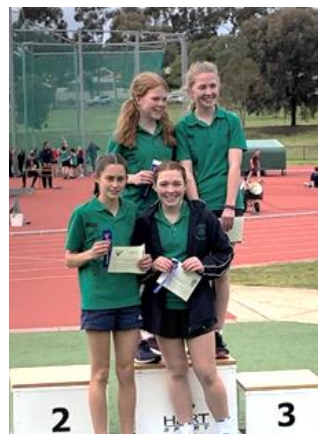
We would like to thank Mrs Coates and Mrs Excel for coming to support us on Monday and taking their time to help us improve and get ready for our events.

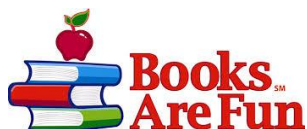
