Dear Families.

Yesterday, Ash Wednesday, was the start of Lent. This marks the Christian season of the six weeks prior to Easter. It is traditionally a time for prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

An important part of this season is the appeal from the Catholic Aid

Agency, Caritas. In 1964, Caritas began in Australia and they have worked to help end poverty, promote justice and uphold dignity so the world's poor won't need to rely on charity.



Each year, our school encourages the students to contribute to this appeal. All the classes will have a Project Compassion Box in their rooms. Children are invited to bring in coins that they may have normally spent on a treat. By doing so they are going without, and raising money for those who are in need. In addition to our class Project Compassion Boxes we will be organising the Caritas K's fundraiser for the whole school on Friday 13th March.

I share with you this reflection from Ann Rennie...

Lent is a time of preparation. It is a time for slowing down and reflecting, taking spiritual stock as we traverse these forty days of fasting, charity and prayer.

It is a time for converting, repenting and forgiving, shaping ourselves up for immersion in the Easter story that is central to the Christian faith.



## **Change to Traffic**

On Sunday 1st March the roundabout outside our school will be re-laid with asphalt from 7.00am to 6pm. This will mean that our school will not be accessible by vehicles till the following day. It also means that parents will need to avoid Somerville Road and Blucher Street on this day.



## **Change to Parish Mass**

The asphalting of the roundabout has also meant there will be a change of venue for our Parish Mass. The venue has now been changed and will be held at St Joseph's Church Axe Creek at 4.30pm.

#### **Learning Conversations**

The Learning Conversations will be held in Week 6 (Monday, 2 March - Thursday, 5 March) This is a wonderful opportunity for students, parents and the teacher to focus on setting Numeracy and Literacy Goals. The aim is to have a rich conversation about how the student is progressing at this stage of the



year. Another component of the learning conversation, is for class teachers to provide each parent with an insight about a possible future social and emotional goal that will benefit their child. This year, you will also hear during the learning conversation about our school attendance target of 95%. The teachers will report each student's individual attendance rate. Student attendance is both the responsibility of the parents and the school.

Teachers will record minutes from the meeting. Copies of the notes from your Learning Conversation will be available to you upon request. I do ask that all parents and students arrive on time for the Learning Conversations next week.

## School Attendance at St. Francis of the Field

Protecting the safety and wellbeing of children through reporting and monitoring of absenteeism is the responsibility of both parents/carers and schools. Since the end of Term 2 2018, all Victorian government schools must contact parents/carers as soon as practicable on the same-day of an unexplained student absence. Parents/carers are required to ensure their child attends school every day and have an obligation to contact the school to notify the school of their child's absence.

Everyday missed can affect a child's educational outcomes.

#### Students with regular attendance (95% and above) have:

- Greater health outcomes
- Higher incomes
- Greater employment opportunities

#### Non attendance can lead to:

- Homelessness
- · Difficulty with employment
- Poverty

This year at our learning conversations you will hear that our target for attendance is 95%. What does this mean for students at St. Francis of the Fields.

- 5 days absent = 1 week = 97% attendance
- 10 days absent = 2 weeks = 95% attendance
- 15 days absent = 3 weeks = 92% attendance
- 20 days absent = 4 weeks = 90% attendance.
- 5 missed days per term = 1.5 years of lost learning over 13 years.

# Conveyance Allowance Program (CAP) 2020



Dear Parents,

The Conveyance Allowance is a form of financial assistance from the Victorian State Government to assist families in rural and regional Victoria with the cost of transporting their children to their nearest appropriate school.

The allowance is available to parents who are required to –

- drive their child more than 4.8 kilometres to school (if there is no school bus)
- or drive their child more than 4.8 kilometres to meet the nearest school bus to the school
- the child must attend their closest government or non-government school (Catholic)
- the allowance is based on kilometres travelled and not based on any financial eligibility

Distance is calculated by the shortest practical route from home to the school or from home to meet the nearest school bus to the school. Distance can be calculated by using Bing Maps.

Forms required to be completed by a parent are available to download from our website http://www.sfstrathfieldsaye.catholic.edu.au/downloads/forms or can be picked up at the office.

- 1. Conveyance Allowance Application 2020 (one per family which includes all children at St Francis of the Fields)
- 2. Conveyance Allowance Authority to Pay Form 2020 (one per parent claiming)
- Parents who received the Conveyance Allowance in 2019 do not need to complete a new form in 2020 unless their children enrolled at St Francis of the Fields in 2019 have changed (ie Yr 6 student left at the end of 2019 or a Prep child commenced in 2020).
- If your family circumstances have changed a new form needs to be completed in 2020.
- If you have recently changed address, please advise the office if you are no longer eligible.

Application and Authority to Pay forms need to be completed and returned to the office by Monday 24 February 2020 please.

# 2020 INSTRUMENTAL PROGRAM ENROLMENTS
